MARIELLE PLAISIR (b. 1978) - Biography

Marielle Plaisir was born in le Havre, Seine-Maritime, France and currently lives and work in the United States. Plaisir spent her childhood and her adolescence in Normandie (France), before setting in Guadeloupe (French Caribbean Island). She is constantly examining her roots through reading and research in her quest for her self-identity.

Plaisir is a French Caribbean multi-media artist, who combines painting, drawing, monumental installations and performance to present highly intense visual experiences.

Her work is a blend of life and history, as well as, the fantastical to create personal narratives and historic narratives. Plaisir touches on universal themes like power, domination, and prejudice. She finds inspiration in Italian quattrocento, Latin, Caribbean and American literature. She uses her daily practice to examine the many aspects of the individual in the society. She uses textiles, fibers, fabrics which are socially meaningful in her works and installations.

Through her artworks, she presents moments of humor and beauty and shows us evidence of humanity in our increasingly digital world. From monumental works, to itinerating in-situ exhibitions, along with books and illustrations for the youth and drawings for animation, Plaisir's works demonstrates a strong urge to produce poetical pieces. Her work is beautiful and poignant.

Marielle Plaisir's essence is theatrical. Since 2002, Plaisir has exhibited in numerous group shows, and solo exhibitions throughout the world. She has participated in various International Biennials of Contemporary Art.

As a textile-artist, she's collaborating with The French designer furniture company Roche-Bobois (Paris). She's also the creative director of LES BARBARES (luxury art-accessories brand).

She is currently in the OOlite ART Studio-residency Program.
